TUNNEL OF DREAMS | NOVEMBER 12-16, 2022 | UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA

- This is a public, collaborative, art installation constructed with tunnel made from rebar, construction fencing, and tension cords. The Tunnel of Dreams is a public and collaborative art installation initiated by the Art Education Graduate Students of the University of Georgia during the Spotlight on the Arts, during a children's event called "Family Day." This art installation had children, their parents, students, and professors partake in weaving fabrics and various other materials into this tunnel and to "weave their dreams and aspirations." The tunnel was approximately 75 feet long, and about 6 feet tall, which was large enough for an adult of average height to walk through. Materials could be woven from the inside and outside of the tunnel.
